

Inkjet Tattoo Film Instructions

This special film allows you to transfer your inkjet image as a personalized tattoo onto your body.

- 1 Handle the paper by the edge to avoid fingerprints and use only single sheet feeding through your printer.
- 2 The printable side is the matt finish side – not the grid pattern side.
- 3 Print using best quality print with a normal paper setting. There is no requirement to use “reverse” or “mirror” printing when printing text.
- 4 After printing let the material dry fully, this could take up to an hour depending on the image/design.
- 5 Cut round the printed area to the desired shape. Ideally the image should be no more than 3-4cm in diameter to make it easier to handle but larger images are possible.
- 6 Carefully peel the Tattoo “membrane” away from the brown backing sheet. This can be tricky and using the sharp end of a needle/pin can help start the process.
- 7 Place the tattoo on a cleansed body area (preferably hair free) smoothing it out as applied. No water is required for this process; it simply sticks to your skin.
- 8 This material can also be used to make finger and toe nail decorations, follow the instructions as above applying a coat of clear nail varnish afterwards.
- 9 The tattoo can easily be removed using soap and water.

Other Information.

- Adult Supervision is recommended.
- Limit use to less than 2 days; wash off with soap and water.
- This material has been dermatologically tested and is suitable for use on skin of normal sensitivity. Please read also the safety instructions from your ink manufacturer.
